I hope you all had as much fun this year as I did and I hope football stays an integral part of your life for many years to come.

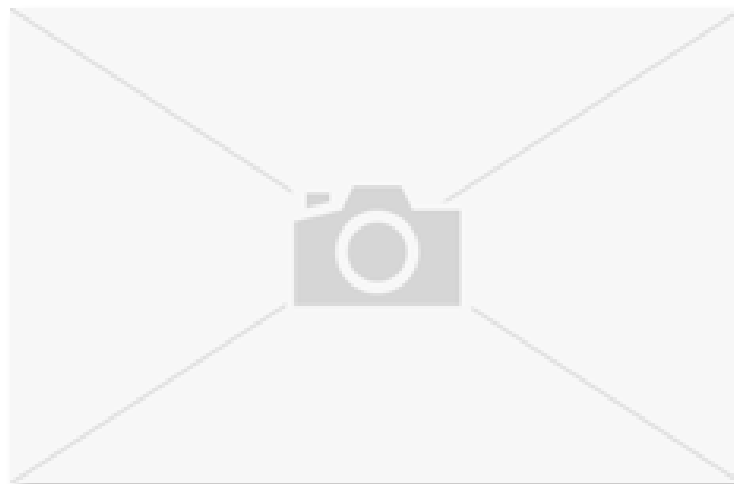

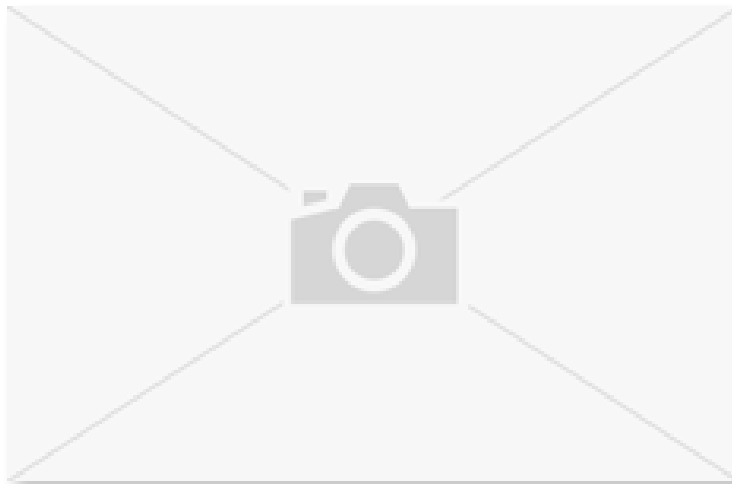
This season we welcomed several new additions to the club, as well as several returning faces. We played well all season, coming in a close fifth to just miss out on the semi-finals.

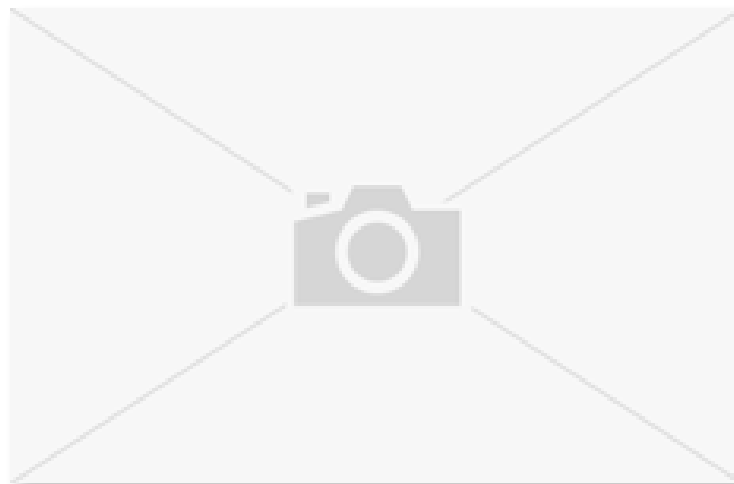
We twice had to guts it out with 7 players, another once or twice with 8 and went so close to beating one of the semi finalists when we had just 9 players.

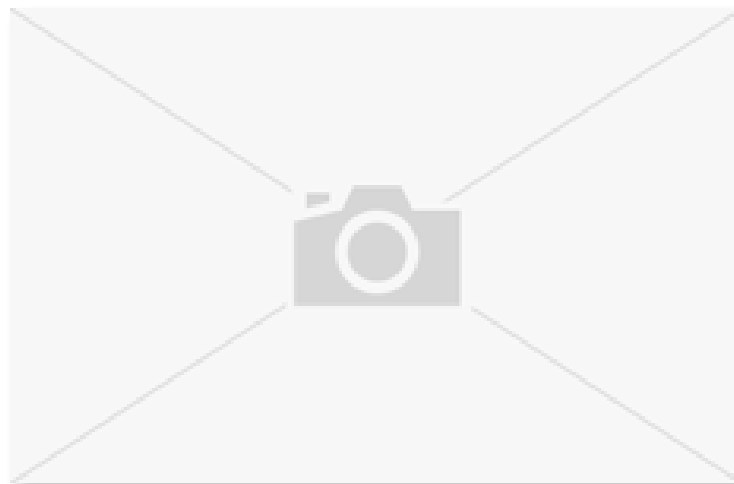
Chin up fellas. We've had a fun competitive season.

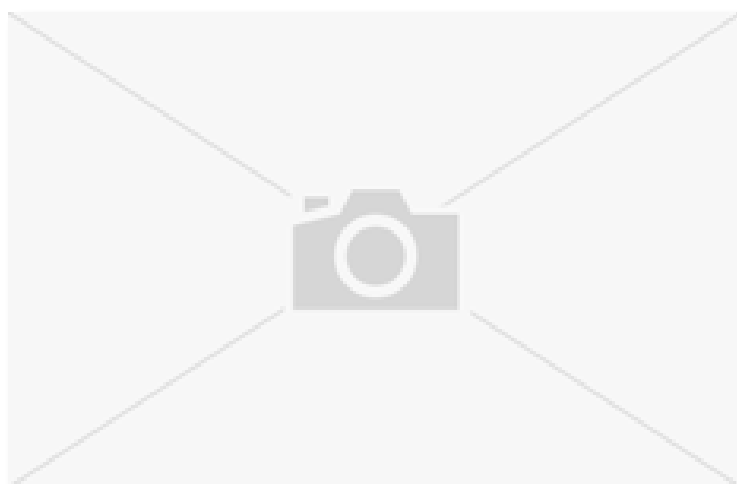

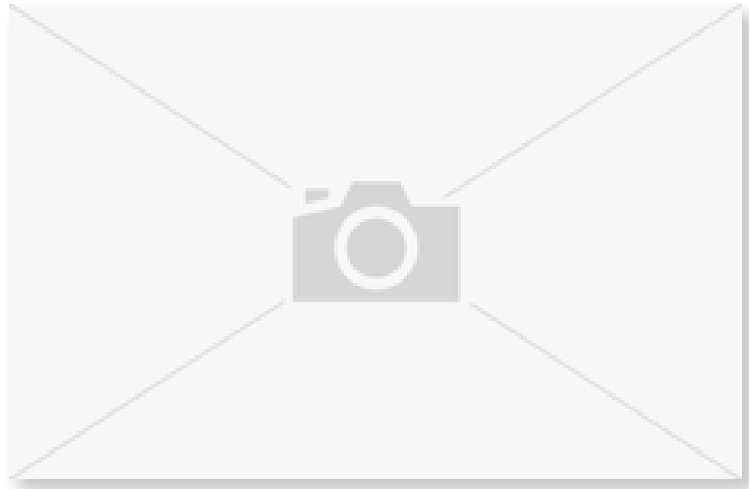

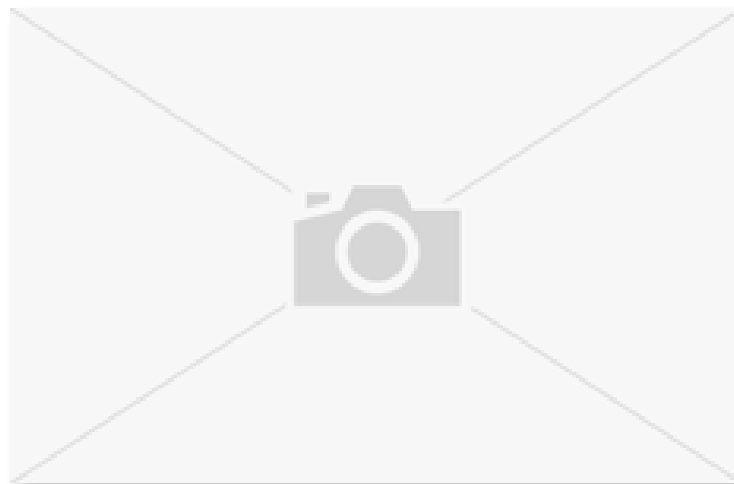
Thank you also to Kristen and Erin for helping me out as the Manager team during the year.
